RE (Come and See)

Eucharist - Relating - Memorial Sacrifice - The children will learn about remembering Jesus and his sacrifice. They will learn about the stages of the Eucharist prayer and what the symbols, actions and words represent.

Science

Materials and their properties

- Compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties.
