Do you have any photographs of Father Southworth that we can copy? If so could you hand them into our Reception Desk staff – we will make sure they are returned to you.

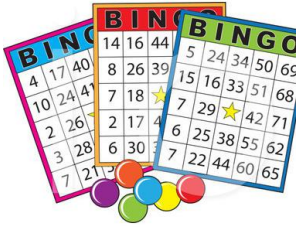
Bonfire Night Safety

- Only buy fireworks marked BS 7114
- Light at arm's length, using a taper
- Follow the instructions on each firework
- Don't drink alcohol if setting off fireworks
- Always supervise children around fireworks
- Never put fireworks in your pocket or throw them
- Never go near a firework that has been lit – even if it hasn't gone off it could still explode

Our School Council

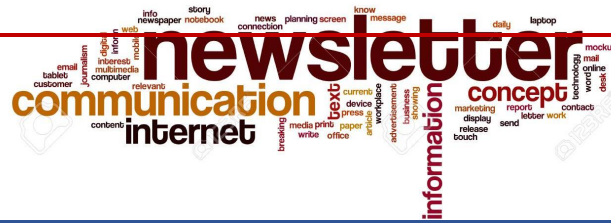

Please park responsibly outside the school ~



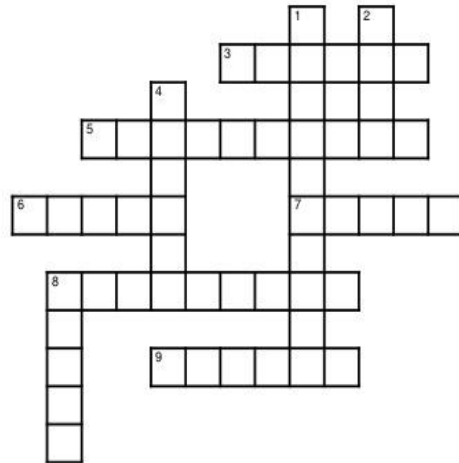
Small children are impetuous, they cannot always be seen – please be aware of them
