Well done to everyone - staff and children and a BIG THANK YOU to our parents for their wonderful support.

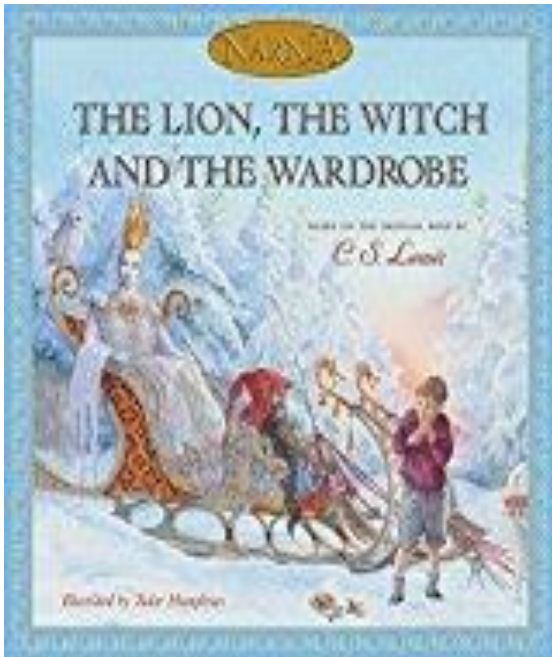
### Outcome of our Readathon - Sponsored Extra Reading
