

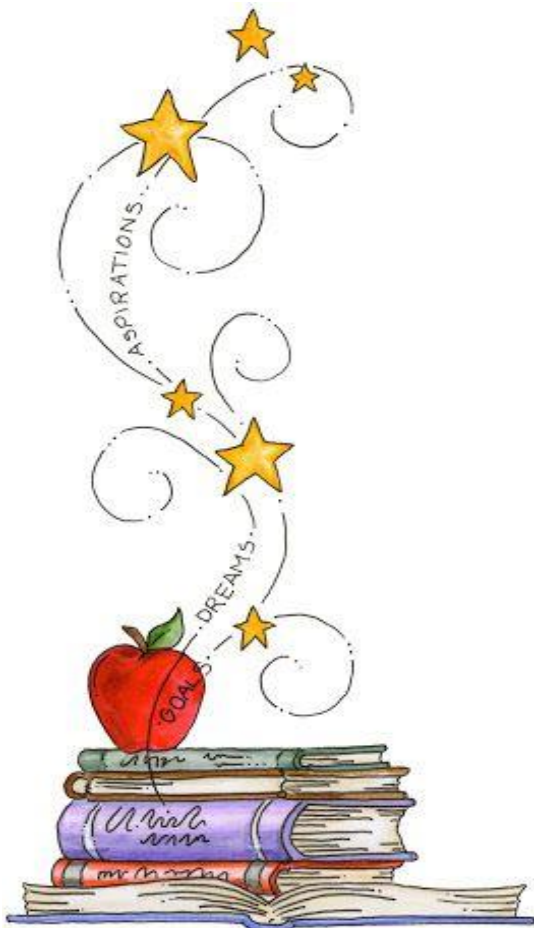

We would like children to think about their aspirations for future careers. What would they like to be or do?



The idea for this originally came from three of our Year 5 girls; Ola, Eva and Tolin who thought that we should all think of ourselves as our own "Superhero" We have developed this further so that children can aspire to reach their career goals.

We have invited adults from different professions to come into school to talk about the skills needed for their particular jobs – for example, an army career, midwifery etc.

We will hold a variety of activities across the school – children will have the opportunity to "interview" adults about their work.

Children will need to think about the qualities/skills needed for their chosen career. Children will complete a Super Me "Passport" which might be fun to keep and compare in the future!
