Dear Parent/ Carer,

I hope this letter finds you and your nearest and dearest all safe and well.

As you may be aware, schools have been open since Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June as hubs for children of key workers or those children who are vulnerable; those with a Social Services "Child in Need" plan or "Child Protection" plan.

Liverpool City Council (LCC), in consultation with other agencies, has now confirmed that schools can open for **Y6 children ONLY from MONDAY 22<sup>nd</sup> June, in so far it is safe to do so.**


St. Finbar's Catholic Primary School will follow the advice from LCC. **School is NOT OPEN** for any children, at this moment, other than key worker children, vulnerable children and children from Y6.

We, like you, miss the normality of being together in school; learning, laughing and loving each day. We miss the smiles, the *light-bulb* moments, the energy, the kindness and the eagerness of our little learners to learn. We want you all back but only when it is safe to do so.

As ever, as soon as we know more information about the possibility of school re-opening for children in other year groups, we will be in touch to share it with you.

I will be in further contact with the parents of Y6 children to explain arrangements for their child's return to school.
