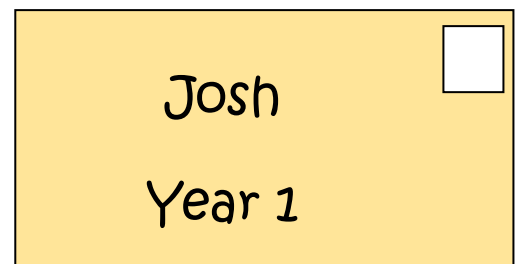
Christmas cards

Under the current Covid-19 restrictions we will put a **POST BOX** on the yard each morning for ALL Christmas cards - this way they can be quarantined before we send them home.

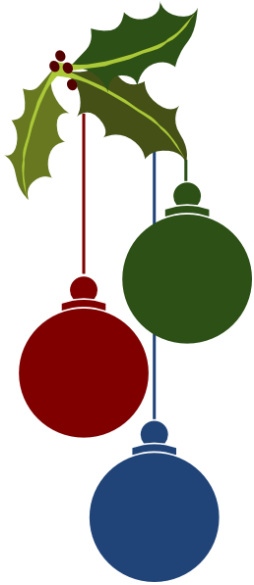
Please help your child with labelling - show name (surname too if you know it) and class clearly on the envelope. Thank you!

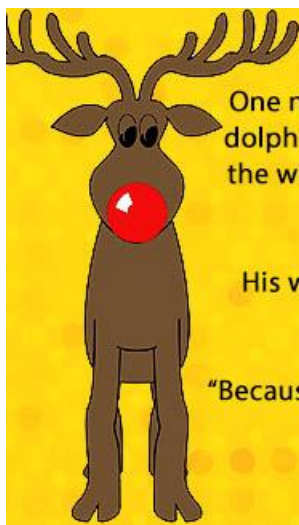
A Chubby Little Snowman
