**Your child is cordially invited to join our VE Day (Victory in Europe Day) celebrations on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2025. Your child will enjoy a fun day and attend our 'Street Party' to celebrate the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of VE Day.**

Our VE Day celebrations will include a non-uniform day and we are asking all children to pay £1 for the privilege of not wearing uniform on this day. Children and staff should come to school wearing red, white and blue clothing. Please note that football kits are not allowed and suitable shoes should be worn.



Please hand your contribution to the class teacher/school office. Money raised will go into our School Fund which supports children by purchasing new books, classroom equipment, celebration awards, prize giving etc.

As part of our celebrations we will also be having a 'street party' at lunchtime.

### **Reception, Year 1 and Year 2**

If your child is in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 they are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) and there is no charge for your child to take part in the 'street party'. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and currently has a school meal, there is nothing for you to do.

If your child normally brings a packed lunch but would like to join in our celebrations, please let us know for catering purposes.

### **Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6**

If your child is in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 and currently has a free school meal (FSM), there is nothing for you to do.

If your child is in Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 and normally brings a packed lunch but would like to join in our celebrations, please let us know for catering purposes. Please pass your child's dinner money to reception on the day. The cost of the meal is £2.50.
