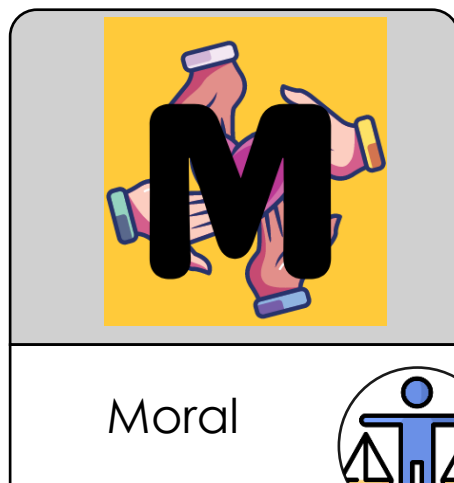
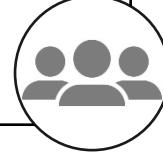
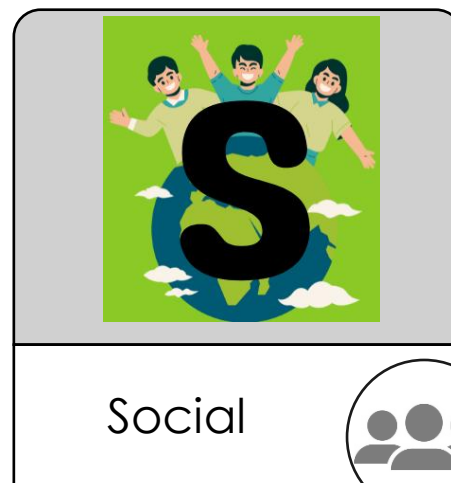


History supports spiritual development by providing children with opportunities to reflect on their own lives and lives of the past.
