## Science

### Living things and their habitats

Children will:

- Outline the similarities in the life cycles of mammals
- Recall the life cycle of amphibians and insects
- Know why variation is important
- Know some plants and animals that reproduce asexually.

## English

**Reading:** Develop skills of inference and prediction across a variety of texts. The class reader is "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory" by Roald Dahl.

**Writing:** We will be reading 'The Errand'. We will write a cliffhanger narrative and an instruction manual

**Grammar & Spelling:** Relative clauses, commas for parenthesis, dashes to mark boundaries, adverbials, direct speech, homophones and near homophones.

## Maths

**Decimals and Percentages:** Children will find equivalent decimals and percentages. They will order and compare decimals and round to decimal places.

**Perimeter and area:** Children will find the perimeter of rectangles, rectilinear shapes and polygons. They will also find the area of rectangles and compound areas.

## History

### Norse Culture

Children will:

- Identify how historians used Sagas to find out more about the Norse Men
- identify why the saga of Erik the Red is remembered today.
- understand how travel was important to the Norse people.
- Explore how the Norse are remembered throughout the story of Beowulf.

## PE

### Netball

Children will:

- Develop the chest, bounce, shoulder and overhead pass
- Select and apply tactical awareness to play competitively, choosing the right shot for the situation.

## Music

### Dynamics

Children will:

- Identify all notes
- Sing, play and identify all notes learned
- Make gradual changes in dynamics
- Play with a varied tempo

## Spanish

### Rooms in the home and furniture

Children will:

- Recognise pieces of bedroom furniture/ items
- Recognise how to combine prepositions with following article
- Show understanding of written longer sentences [rooms/ furniture/ prepositions]

## Computing

### Being a Youtuber

Children will:

- Discuss why Youtube is so popular
- Understand how Youtubers make money
- Explore what can go wrong
- Make and edit their own vlog

## Art/DT

### Cooking and Nutrition

Children will:

- Research a traditional recipe and make changes to it
- Add nutritional value to a recipe and make changes to it
- Prepare and cook a version of Bolognese sauce

## Geography

### North and South America

Children will:

- Identify and locate North and South America
- Understand what a megacity is.
- Locate São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro Understand why people migrate from rural Brazil to cities such as São Paulo.
- Describe how life in the favelas is represented versus experienced.

## RSHE

### Drugs, alcohol and tobacco

Children will identify what smoking drugs there are. They will understand the different influences, both positive and negative, that might persuade people to use smoking drugs.
