

# Bluebell (Nursery) Curriculum overview Autumn 2 2025

## **RE** (To Know You More Clearly) Galilee to Jerusalem

This half term we will be learning about The Wise Men's visit to Jesus. We will also be learning about Jesus's love for little children and how we can show love to those around us.

## **Physical development**

**Fine motor skills:** To use scissors to cut card by moving forward and working towards cutting in a continuous line

To fasten buttons on clothes.

**Gross motor skills:** To run with spatial awareness and negotiate space successfully, adjusting speed or direction to avoid obstacles

## **Personal, Social & Emotional development**

**Managing feelings and behaviour, making relationships, self-confidence and self-awareness.**

To understand that they are part of, and belong to, the school community.

To enjoy a sense of belonging through being involved in keeping the room tidy by tidying up after themselves.

## **Communication & Language** **Speaking, listening and understanding:**

To begin to answer "who" and "what" questions in relation to a story, identifying "who is doing what" and remembering parts of "what happened"

## **English**

**Reading:** To listen to longer stories and poems with increasing attention.

To show interest in illustrations.

To join in with repeated refrains.

**Writing:** To begin to give meaning to the marks that we make.

**Phonics:** Rhyme, environmental sounds.

## **Maths**

**Numeracy: Join in with repeats.**

Explore position and space.

Show me 1, 2, 3.

Move and label 1, 2, 3.

Explore position and routes.

## **Understanding the world**

To understand seasonal changes in Winter  
To identify the clothes that are worn in winter and why  
To explore freezing, melting and observe evaporation

## **Expressive arts and design**

To sing to self and makes up simple songs.  
To use available resources to create props.

## **Events & celebrations**

Parents' evenings, whole school and class assemblies, theme days etc. including dates are always added to the calendar on the school website. Please check the website regularly.

## **Learning Life skills**

As we are nearing the half way point of the academic year we will be looking back at all the things we have learnt so far this year. We will be reminding the children about their new learning and talking about how resilience has helped them to keep trying when things have seemed tough.

## **Learning in the environment**

We will be looking at the seasonal changes that are happening this term as winter starts to turn into spring. We will be looking for signs of the seasons in our outdoors environment.

## **Family Learning**

One of the key things we will be working on is our independence. We would ask that you could please support your child to be able to put their own coat on and once you have clipped the zip in they can practise zipping it up.
