Year 6 Talk Consent

The aim of these sessions is to empower students with the knowledge and skills needed to navigate boundaries, respect others and understand consent.

About Talk Consent

Talk Consent is a respected educational organisation with experience delivering effective, age-appropriate sessions to hundreds of schools across the country.

For primary students, the emphasis is on creating a foundation of respect, confidence in personal boundaries, and clear, safe communication. The material is grounded in the reality of students' lives and the content will be appropriate for their age.

What will be covered?

Year 6 Healthy Relationship Workshop

Through an interactive game-based workshop, students learn to understand healthy relationships and friendships and recognise harmful behaviour.

The workshop covers:

- What a healthy relationship looks like
- Recognising red flags and harmful behaviour
- Managing difficult emotions and conflict resolution
